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**ESOPHAGOGASTRODUODENOSCOPY  
(ENDOSCOPY)**

**One week before your endoscopy:** No Aspirin, Advil, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Aleve, Excedrin, Vitamin E, Arthrotec, Celebrex, fish oil or any other NSAIDS (non-steroid anti-inflammatory drugs).

You may use **Tylenol** the week before.

**Please notify us if you are using Coumadin, Plavix, Ticlid, Clopidogrel, Xarelto, Eliquis or any other blood thinning products.**

**Preparation:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before the procedure; nothing to eat or drink in the morning.

If you are diabetic and take oral medication to control your diabetes, please DO NOT take your medications the morning of your endoscopy.

**DUE TO SEDATION, YOU WILL NEED TRANSPORTATION HOME FROM YOUR ENDOSCOPY.**

**YOU CANNOT DRIVE YOURSELF. NO TAXI, BUS OR WALKING HOME ALONE; A FRIEND, RELATIVE, OR NEIGHBOR MUST TRANSPORT/ACCOMPANY YOU HOME.**
